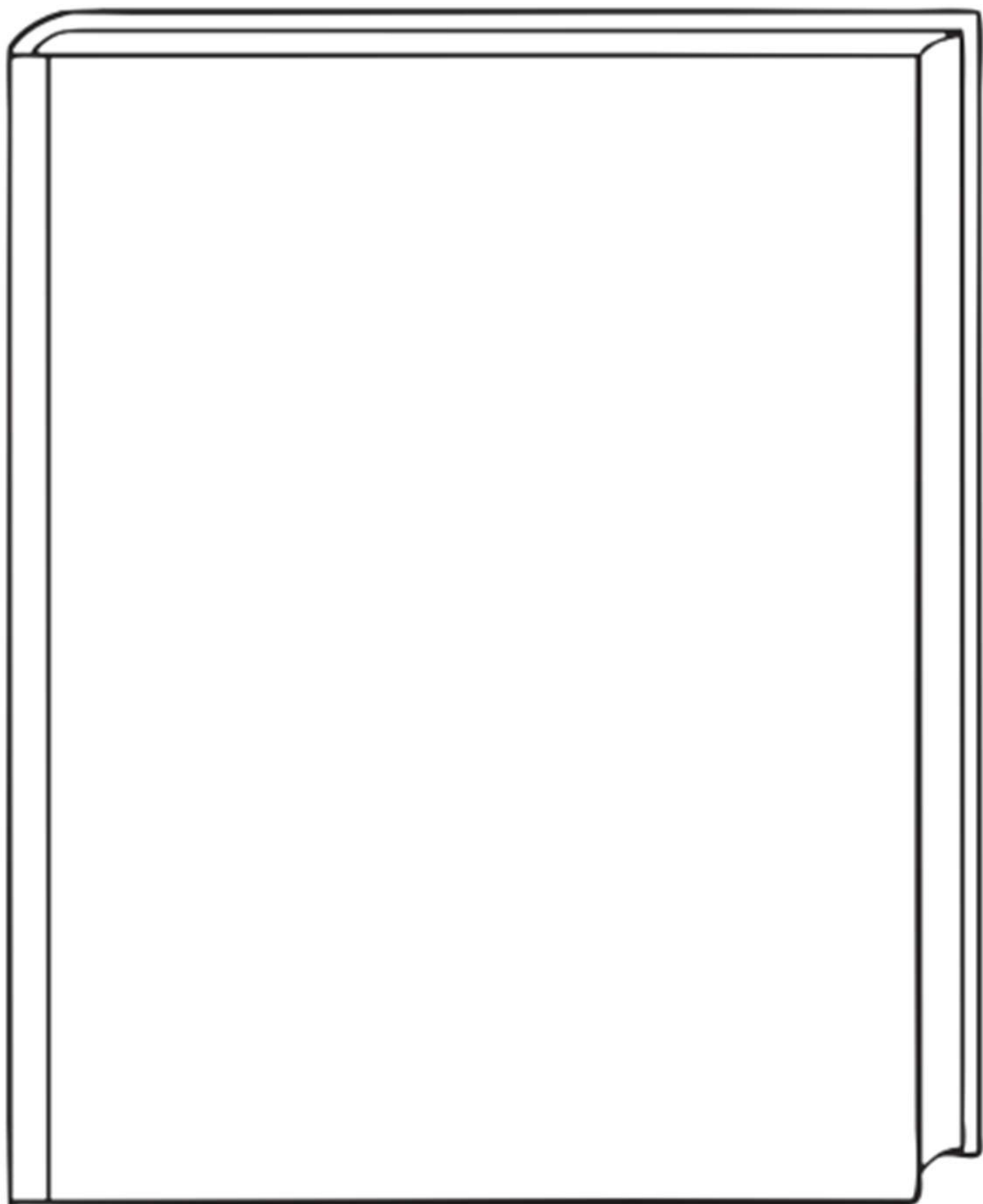


**Year 4 Remote Learning Daily Plan - Day 37 - Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March**

<p>Maths</p>	<p>Main Lesson - <b>Calculate fractions of a quantity</b>. There is no Seesaw video today. The answers will follow so you can mark your own work.</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 1 minutes 03 seconds. Look at the questions on the video. How do you think we could calculate fractions of a quantity?</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 1 minutes 35 seconds. What do you notice about these questions? What has stayed the same? What has changed?</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 2 minutes 43 seconds. Can you work out what <math>\frac{1}{8}</math> of 112 is and <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> of 112 is from the calculation <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> of 112 is 28?</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 3 minutes 43 seconds. Can you use the method you have just been shown to calculate the 3 questions on the screen?</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 4 minutes 14 seconds. What do you notice about these questions? What has stayed the same? What has changed?</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 5 minutes 20 seconds. Can you find a method to calculate the questions on the screen?</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 6 minutes 20 seconds. Can you find a method to calculate the questions on the screen?</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 6 minutes 55 seconds. What do you notice about these questions? What has stayed the same? What has changed?</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 7 minutes 54 seconds. Can you find a method to calculate the questions on the screen?</li> <li>• Pause the video at 8 minutes 59 seconds and have a go at questions 1-5 on the worksheet.</li> <li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 9 minutes 06 seconds. Can you decide if the calculation needs a more than, less than or equals sign?</li> <li>• Now complete the rest of the worksheet.</li> </ul>
