

**Year 4 Remote Learning Daily Plan - Day 12 - Monday 25<sup>th</sup> January**

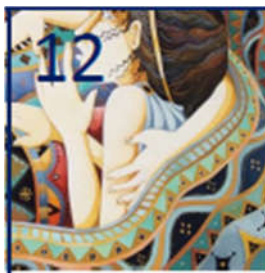
Maths	<p>Main Lesson -Dividing 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers. There is no Seesaw video today. Start by watching today's Maths video called 'Divide 3-digits by 1-digit'. Some questions may require you to use counters. The answers will follow so you can mark your own work.</li><li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 4 minutes and 41 seconds. Have a go at completing 765 divided by 5 and 201 divided by 3 using either the place value chart or part-whole method.</li><li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 4 minutes and 41 seconds. Have a go at completing 708 divided by 7 and 865 divided by 4 using either the place value chart or part-whole method.</li><li>• Now have a go at questions 1-5 on the worksheet.</li><li>• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 8 minutes and 30 seconds and see if you can work out how much money Tom would have left after dividing £317 between his 5 grandchildren.</li><li>• Now complete the rest of your worksheet.</li></ul>
English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Today we are beginning our new topic and story.</li><li>• Look at the pictures on the English resource page. These pictures are of the front cover and the back page of our new story cut into pieces. Look carefully at each image and try to predict what you think this story could be about. Use the mind map on the English resource page to write down your ideas.</li><li>• Answer the following questions on the resource sheet.<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ <i>Who do you think the characters are?</i></li><li>○ <i>How do you think they are feeling?</i></li><li>○ <i>Where do you think they are going?</i></li><li>○ <i>What do you think has happened to them?</i></li></ul></li><li>• If you could ask the characters on the front cover 3 question, what would they be? Write these answers on the resource sheet.</li></ul> <p>The front cover and back page will be revealed tomorrow!</p>
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• We are beginning our new topic this week which is 'Animals including Humans'.</li><li>• This week, we are focusing on the digestive system. The digestive system is all the parts of your body that help you break down all the food that you eat. Using the mind map on the Science resource page and just 1 colour, write down anything you may know about the digestive system and the route your food goes on when placed in your mouth. Think about where it starts and where it might end. What do you think happens between those two places?</li><li>• Now watch the video on the link below. Using a different coloured pen/pencil, add any new things that you discovered in the video to your spider diagram. 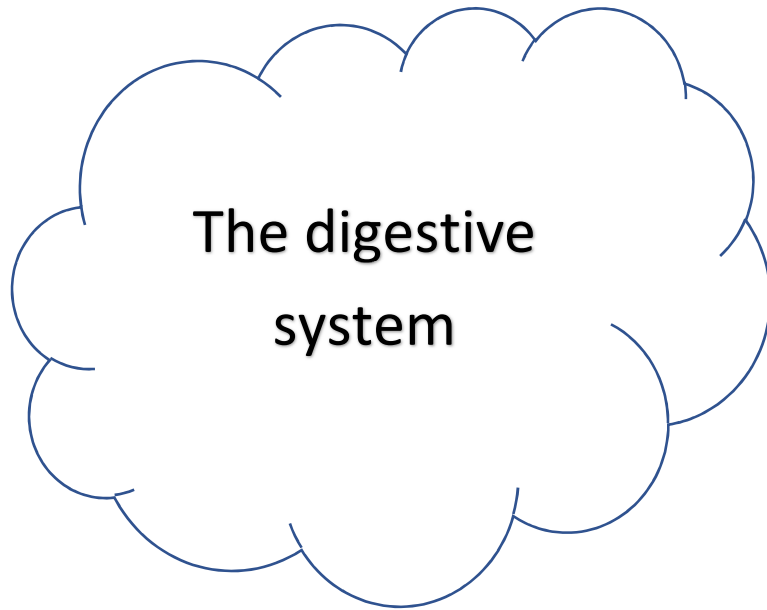
