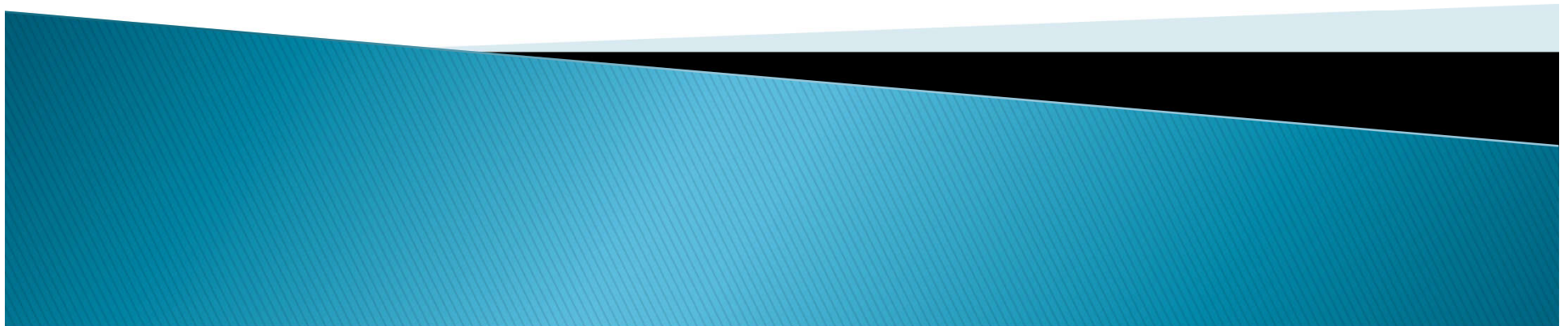
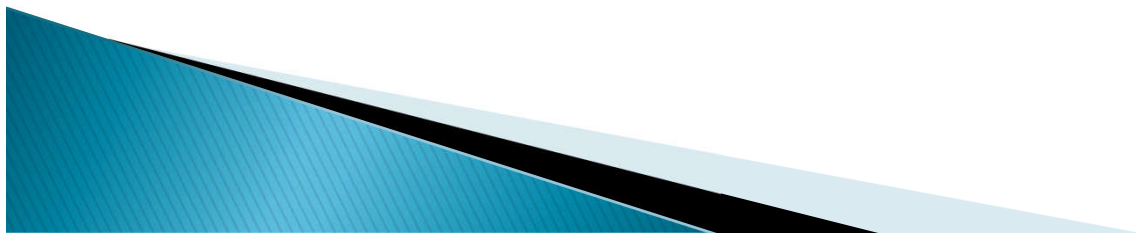


Can I understand how

beliefs and values in public?

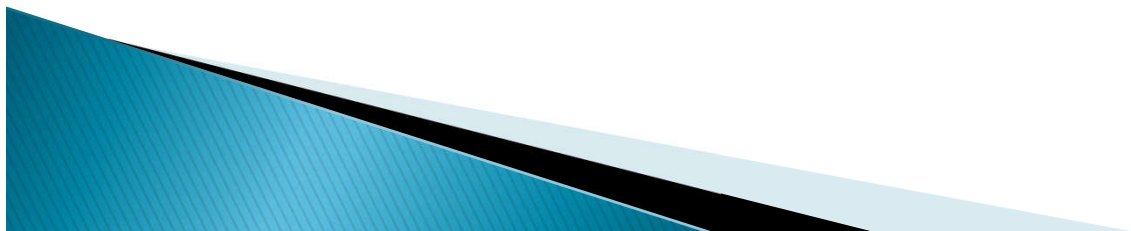

- ▶ Are there things that you notice about some people that tells you about their identity?



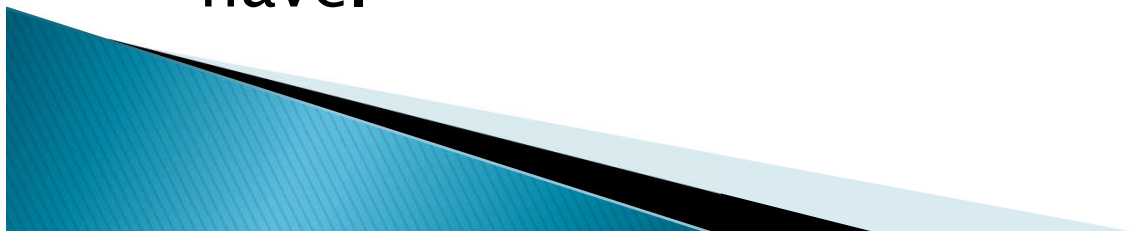
- ▶ You can identify certain people from the clothes that they wear or the way they look. This could be as simple as a football shirt as you can learn which team they support.

- ▶ On the next slide, can you identify something about the people by just by looking at their clothes?





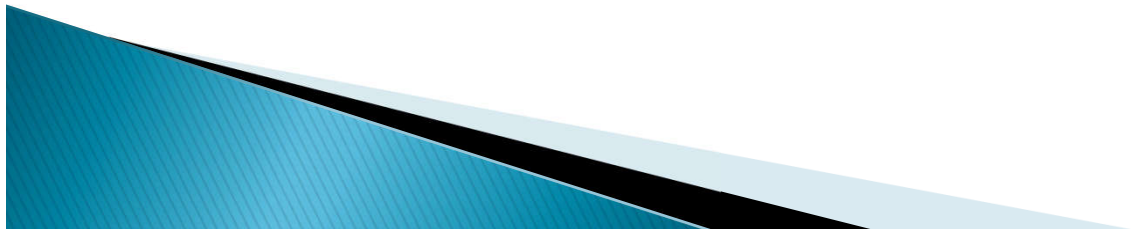
# What does it mean to commit to something?
