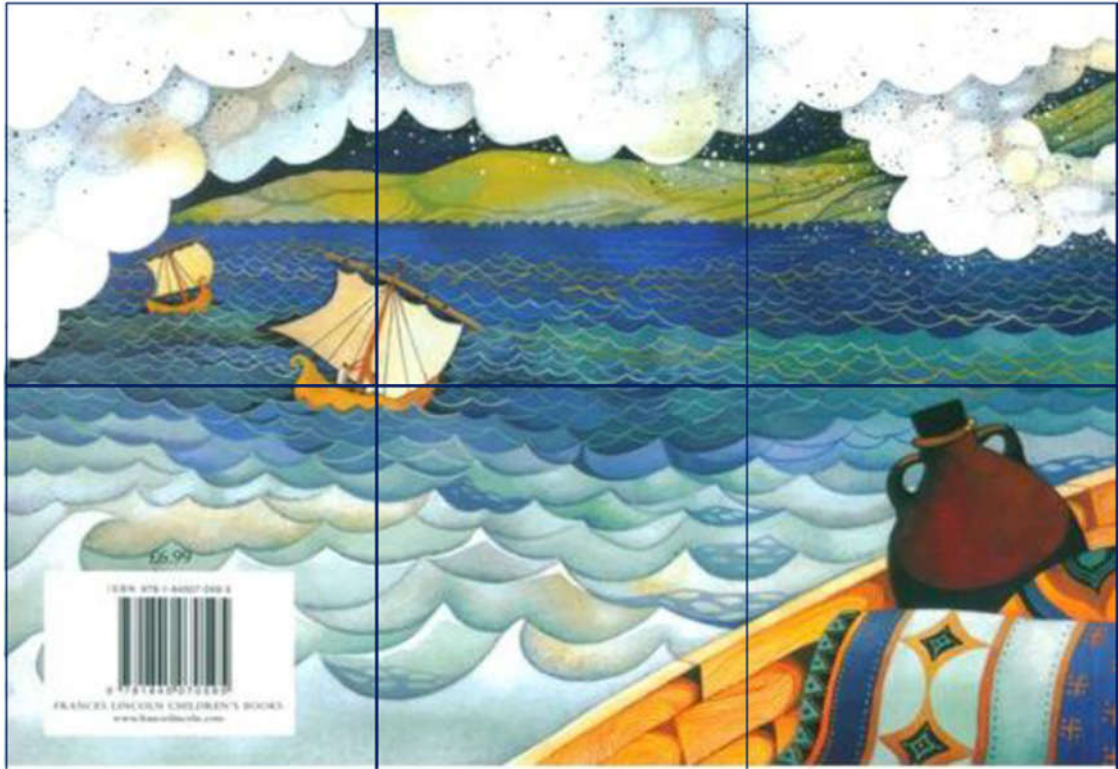


Year 4 Remote Learning Daily Plan - Day 14 - Wednesday 27th January

Maths	<p>Main Lesson -Correspondence problems. There is no Seesaw video today. Start by watching today's Maths video called 'What is Area?'</p> <p>https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-4/spring-week-4-measurement-area/</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Pause the video after 15 seconds - have a go at the 'Get Ready' questions on a piece of paper. The answers will follow so you can mark your own work.• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 1 minutes and 02 seconds. Have a go at working out question 1 on your worksheet. If you don't have sticky notes, 4 equal squares cut from paper will be fine.• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 4 minutes and 26 seconds. Who is correct in measuring the area of the shape? Why are the others incorrect?• Watch the next section of the video -pause the video at 6 minutes and 25 seconds. Can you create a shape with a smaller area and a larger area?• Now complete the rest of your worksheet.

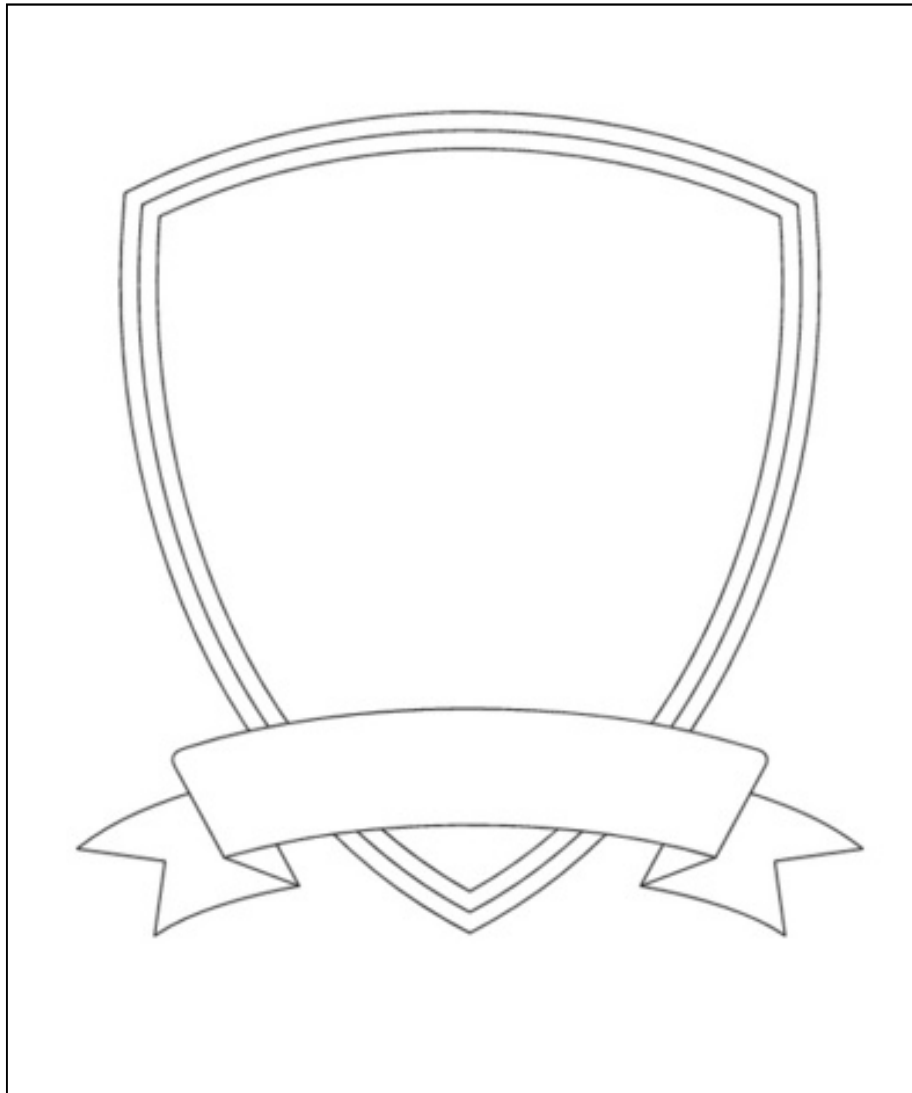
